Maria Costanzo (nee Colangelo) was born in the Belmont section of the Bronx in 1969. At the time, her parents lived at 732 E. 187th St. between Prospect and Crotona Avenues. Both her parents emigrated from Stigliano, Italy, a small town in the mountains of the Basilicata region of Italy. Her mother Lucia was a seamstress and her father a mechanic. Her mother came to America in 1961 when she was 19 years old and settled in the Southern Boulevard section of the Bronx. She later went back to Italy and met Maria's father. They were married two years later and he then joined her in America. Her father worked at a gas station on the corner of Fordham Road and Arthur Avenue.
